All enrollment is on a space-available basis.

Mail-in priority registration for **CURRENT** participants begins on **Monday, April 6** and continues through **Friday, April 16, 2009**, or until sites fill, whichever comes first. If we receive your registration before April 6, it will be held and processed with the mail on April 6.

Mail-in registration for **NEW** participants begins on **Monday, April 20, 2009** and continues until the program is full. If we receive your registration before April 20, it will be held and processed with the mail on April 20. **Note: There is a possibility that not all locations will have openings on April 20.**

Streamlined Registration Process: If you register for **both** Summer 2009 **and** School-Year 2009/10 **at the same time** you will only need to include **one** \$40 registration fee!

- ◆ A non-refundable \$40 family registration fee must accompany all registrations.
Streamlined Registration Process: If you register for **both** Summer 2009 **and** School-Year 2009/10 **at the same time** you will only need to include **one** \$40 registration fee.
- ◆ If you register for Summer 2009 **only**, include a \$40 registration fee with your Summer 2009 Registration.
- ◆ If you register for School-Year 2009 /10 **only**, include a \$40 registration fee with your School-Year 2009/10 Registration.
- ◆ In most cases, Summer registrations received before June 5, 2009 can start care on June 15.
(Registrations accepted on a space-available basis.)
- ◆ In most cases, School-Year registrations received before August 28, 2009 can start care on the first day of school.
(Registrations accepted on a space-available basis.)

ADVENTURE CONNECTION & THE EDGE

Adventure Connection Fees:

Effective for Sept. 2009 care.

Registration fee: \$40

(See streamlined registration info.)

Before School: 6:30 AM to school start time

\$7.50 per day (full-time)

\$9.25 per day (part-time)

\$12.25 per day (drop-in)

After School: School release time to 6:00 PM

Includes snack

\$7.75 per day (full-time)

\$9.75 per day (part-time)

\$12.75 per day (drop-in)

Non-School Day: 6:30 AM - 6:00 PM

\$29 per day (full/part-time participants registered by priority deadline)

\$36 per day (full/part-time participants registered after priority deadline and all non-school-day-only and drop-in participants)

Schedule Options:

Full-Time:

A child's schedule is considered full-time when attendance is 5 days a week (the same schedule each day).

Part-Time:

A child's schedule is considered part-time when attendance is 1-4 days a week (the same days and the same schedule each week).

Drop-in:

For families who need occasional care on school days. Call the site during office hours at least 24 hours before care is needed. Drop-in care requires Visa/Mastercard on file; payments will not be accepted on site. (Drop-in care is on a space available basis, and may not be available at some locations.)

Non-School Days:

A full day program (6:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.) is available at consolidated sites. The deadline to register is listed on individual non-school-day flyers which will be mailed to you in your monthly billing statement. Fees include a morning and afternoon snack and milk for lunch, most field trips and activities.
